

According to MoU, both the institutions agreed to exchange scientific information and scientific materials, arrange personnel visits, share cost of various academic activities etc.



MoU between the College of Pharmacy, University of the Punjab and the University of Huddersfield, UK on November 25, 2019.

MoU was signed to explore, purify and characterize new sources of sustainable nano-materials for various industrial applications. Senior staff from the institutions will communicate and meet regularly to promote this collaboration in various areas of mutual interest.



MoU between the Pakistan Study Centre, University of the Punjab and the Sichuan University, China on December 16, 2019.

Both the universities agreed to exchange teachers and researchers in teaching and scientific research. The universities would provide all possible opportunities available on their respective campuses for students of both institutions to enroll in undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD programs.





MoU between the University of the Punjab and the Punjab Energy Efficiency and Conservation Agency, Energy Department, Government of the Punjab on February 19, 2020.



MoU between the Institute of Agricultural Sciences, University of the Punjab and the Pakistan Red Crescent Society on November 13, 2019.

PU and PRCS would carry out cooperative activities related to environmental issues including climate change effects on agriculture, human and environmental health and air quality. Both the parties would promote renewable energy and emission reductions from deforestation and forest degradation.



MoU between the Centre of Excellence in Molecular Biology (CEMB), University of the Punjab and the Aleenah Agriculture Co., Sudan on December 31, 2019.

Punjab University signed agreement with an African company for the seed business and technical cooperation on the use of Centre of Excellence in Molecular Biology (CEMB)-patented transgenes for development, seed production and marketing of transgenic cotton hybrids/varieties.



MoU between the Institute of Applied Psychology, University of the Punjab and the Department of Psychiatry, Michigan State University, USA on January 15, 2020.

According to MoU, Michigan State University's Department of Psychiatry would assist in providing professional training in psychological skills, psychiatric diagnostic concepts and psychotherapy techniques for students in the institute to provide exposure and improve skills.



MoU between the University of the Punjab and the Center for International Studies (Ce.S.I), Rome, Italy signed virtually on May 5, 2020.



MoU between the University of the Punjab and the University of Palermo (UNIPA), Italy on February 7, 2020.



MoU between the University of the Punjab and the Centre for Global & Strategic Studies (CGSS), Islamabad on March 4, 2020.

The institutions agreed to facilitate cooperation in the areas of mutual interest. It was decided that CGSS and PU will work together to promote joint research projects on agreed fields for developing a sound cooperation in the future.







She said that there was need to introduce new academic courses in pharmaceutical sciences with mutual cooperation. As per MoU, both the universities would exchange faculty members and students for sharing knowledge and experience of each other and organize other academic activities.

It was decided in the MoU that Dunhuang Academy and PU will work together to promote joint research projects on agreed fields for developing a sound cooperation in the future.



## **DEL in COVID-19 Pandemic**






