This Turkish language course is meant for the true second level of the beginning. It is designed to achieve the lower A1 (A1.2) level specified in the Common European Framework for Languages (CEFR). Students will be taught common daily basis language structure, phrases, and ways to describe personal and environmental details. They will also learn how to interact simply. Students will learn to write using Turkish writing according to grammatical structure. Basic adjectives and adverbs suffixes will be thought of at this level.
