


Foreword

This brief fact book on the University of the Punjab (PU) provides readers all basic facts and figures pertaining to PU for the years 2017-18. I would like to thank Mr. Amjad Pervaiz (Director Press & Publications), Mr. Jaleel Tariq (Additional Registrar-I) and Mr. Mahmood Alam (Staff Officer to VC) for their contribution to this fact book.

The readers will notice that certain basic parameters, which indicate performance of a university, have improved steadily and significantly over time. The number of research publications in journals carrying an impact-factor has increased. Publications in HEC recognized journals are in addition to these. This year the number of total research publications reached 1378.

Research funding has been increased up to Rs. 150 million in 2017-18. A research endowment fund (started with 250 million in 2010) currently at Rs 600 million exists in addition to this funding. An amount of Rs. 70 million has been allocated for Faculty Development in 2017-18. This is in addition to HEC and PHEC funded Faculty Development programs. Under these programs over 100 faculty members have been sent abroad for Ph.D. studies and many of them have returned in

the past four or five years, adding to the pool of Ph.Ds in PU. An endowment fund of Rs. 30 million has also been setup for the welfare of employees. The investment of PU has risen to Rs. 6.675 Billion in December, 2017.

There are 829 regular faculty members with 454 Ph.D. degree holders. The Ph.D. to non-Ph.D. ratio has increased by 54.76 % for regular faculty members in the year 2018. Teachers are pursuing their Ph.D. studies from well reputed foreign and national universities. The University has strengthened its M.Phil./MS and Ph.D. programs. In the year 2017-18 student enrollment in M.Phil. and Ph.D. classes rose to 5383 and 1844 respectively. In 2017, 1323 M.Phil. and 112 Ph.D. graduates have completed their degrees. The number of Ph.D. students at the University also increased up to 4% during the current session.

Punjab University is the oldest and largest seat of learning in Pakistan. It comprises 13 faculties and 79 departments whereas 44754 students are admitted in about 350 academic programs. University has about 658 affiliated colleges with about 151,847 students in various disciplines.

To alleviate financial hardships of students, needy & merit scholarships are provided. In 2017, more than 33% of the regular full time students were provided scholarships. We received Rs.137.818 million as fees from regular students and disbursed scholarships worth Rs.73.6 million amongst the students from the income of University of the Punjab. The HEC provided scholarships worth Rs. 79.65 million whereas the Government of the Punjab provided scholarships worth Rs. 26.863 million.

At the end of the booklet we have a list of FAQ's and their answers for further information of the readers. It is expected that this fact book, will be of use to anyone seeking information about Punjab University at a glance.


