No. 1 From the following particulars prepare a bank reconciliation statement of Alfa Traders for the month of December 2019 after making adjustments in the cash book. Q. No. 2 The following errors were detected in the books of Nazir & Sons on 31st December, 2019. The difference in the Trail Balance has been transferred to a Suspense A/c. The final accounts had been prepared on the basis of incorrect figures and the net profit disclosed by the profit and loss Account was Rs. 70,000.

- Sales returns book was under cast by Rs. 2000.
- Purchase of stationery valued Rs. 10,000 is wrongly debited to purchase account.
- Wages paid for the installation of equipment was debited to wages account Rs. 7,000
- Cash received from Qasim had been debited in the cash book Rs. 5,000, but not credited to Qasim A/c.
- Sales book was under cast by Rs.3 000.
- Cash paid to Khurram (Creditor) had been credited in the cash book Rs. 2, 000, but was not debited to Khurram account.

Required: a) Give journal entries to rectify the above errors and prepare suspense account. Further find out the correct net profit for the year.

Q. No. 3. On 1st January, 2019, Mr. Gulzar purchased office furniture of Rs. 7,00,000, from Inter-Wood company. He paid Rs.2,00,000 and for the balance issued a six month, 6 % promissory note. On the same date Inter-Wood discounted the note from its bank at 2%. At maturity Mr. Grulzar failed to meet his obligation and issued a new 6 Month, 6% promissory note for the principle plus interest outstanding relating to old promissory note in favor of Inter-Wood's bank. On December 31, 2019, Mr. Gulzar became insolvent and only 80 paisa in a rupees received from him.

Required: (a) Record the above transactions in Mr. Gulzar's journal and write up the relevant T-accounts in general ledger.

Q. No. 4 Tariq and Saeed have been in partnership for one year sharing profits and losses in the ratio of Tariq 3/5 & Saeed 2/5. They are entitled to 5% per annum interest on capitals, Tariq having Rs.60, 000 capital and Saeed Rs.40,000. Saeed is to have a salary of Rs.5,000. They are charged interest on drawings, Tariq being charged Rs.5,000 and Saeed Rs.1,000. The net profit, before any distributions to the partners, amounted to Rs.50, 000 for the year ended 31 December 2019.

Required: A) Make entries for the recording interest on capital & drawings, charging salary and the distribution of adjusted profit between the partners.
