• Student Counseling and Career Guidance

- Institute of Applied Psychology, University of the Punjab has been offering Students Counseling & Assessment Services to the bona fide students of Punjab University since 2005 in departmental premises. However since 2008 the facility has been moved to the premises of Health Centre under the patronage of worthy Vice-chancellor.
- All registered University students are eligible to receive counseling services at the SCAS and services are free of cost for the university students. Stress, depression, lack of confidence, relationship problem, personal conflicts, poor time management, indecisiveness, exams anxiety etc are some of the problems which adversely effect their academic functioning and are being addressed through counseling.



- The number of students benefiting from counseling services has been increasing gradually and they have shown good progress.

- Awareness among University students about SCAS by putting up Stall for 3 days at ICAPP organized by Department of Applied Psychology in the University premises in December 2012.
- Research collaboration with Institute of Applied Psychology, University of the Punjab Lahore.
- Community work program was organized by Institute of Applied Psychology to give awareness and orientation about psychological well being and counseling services provided at SCAS for University students.
- Group counseling sessions were also organized in the premises of Institute of Applied Psychology for Balochistani Students. Their individual problems in academics, adjustment, in language and in general were addressed in group sessions.
- In collaboration with a team of psychologists from Centre for Clinical Psychology a visit to Gujrat was also arranged to meet the families of the victims of a school van incident. Counseling services were provided to the effected families and follow up with those families is still continued.
