BACHELOR OF SCIENCE EXAMINATIONS FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES

Regulations:

There shall be following two special categories for Bachelor of Science Examinations in Part-II:

Category I:

A candidate who has passed the Ist Professional M.B.,B.S. the Second Professional B.D.S. or Second Professional B. Pharmacy / Pharm-D Examination of this University or equivalent may be permitted to appear as a private candidate, in the subject of English of the B.Sc., and if successful, may be granted the B.Sc. Degree (out of one hundred marks without indicating the division).

Category II:

A candidate who has passed the four years training in General Nursing and Midwifery Examination of the Nursing Council or Male Nurses on production of certificate issued by the MS of concerned Hospital having one year experience in Trauma Casualty, may be permitted to appear as a private candidate, in the subjects of Islamic Studies / Ethics & Pakistan Studies and English of the B.Sc., and if successful, may be granted the B.Sc. Degree (out of two hundred marks without indicating the division).

Provided further that:

- i. The candidates appearing in the examinations as a special category under these regulations shall have to appear and pass as a whole in Annual or Supplementary Examination and no grace marks will be awarded to them.
- ii. The minimum number of marks required to pass this examination shall be same as in Bachelor of Science examination.
- **iii.** All the candidates appearing under these regulations shall for all other purposes be governed by the Regulations dealing with the examination concern i.e. Bachelor of Science.
