

### **Admission Regulations for Undergraduate Programs:**

1. Applicants age must not be more than 24 years of age on the closing date fixed for the online form submission. However, No age limit for Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs.
2. FA / F.Sc. or equivalent with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> division.

### **OR**

1. The admission to BS (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) or equivalent programs will be made provisionally on the basis of the result of the Intermediate (Part-I) Examination-2022 or Equivalent for candidates who have appeared in the final examination of Intermediate Part –II (2023) or Equivalent and are waiting for their results.
- The provisional admissions of BS 1st Semester will be made on the basis of the result of the Intermediate Part-I. The admission shall, however, be provisional, subject to the required passing marks of the candidate in Intermediate (Part-II) Examination-2023. In case of failure in the 2023 (Part-II) examination, the provisional admission made in 1st Semester shall automatically be cancelled.
- After provisional admission and depositing fee or dues in the University account, the students shall be required to submit their Intermediate or Equivalent Part-II (pass) result card 2023 within stipulated time period in the relevant Departments.

### **Admission Regulations for Undergraduate Programs of Engineering Disciplines (Chemical Engineering, Energy Engineering, Metallurgy & Materials Engineering, Industrial Engineering & Management, Electrical Engineering):**

1. Applicants age must not be more than 24 years on the closing date of the online form submission.
2. F.Sc. (Pre-Engineering) / DAE / ICS / A-Level or equivalent with at least 60% Marks.
3. Must have appeared secured at least 33% Marks in any of the test, (E-CAT by UET Lahore or PU-E or PU-CSP or Entry Test by NUST for Engineering) in accordance with Pakistan Engineering Council Regulations.

### **Admission Regulations for BS (5<sup>th</sup> Semester) Replacement of MA/M.Sc. Old Programs or Equivalent Program:**

1. Applicant's age must not be more than 26 years on the closing date of the online form submission. There is no age limit for Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs.
2. BA / B.Sc./Associate Degree (Science/Arts/Commerce) or equivalent with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> division.

### **OR**

3. The admission to BS (5th Semester) or equivalent programs will be made provisionally on the basis of the result of Associate Degree (Science/Arts/Commerce) or equivalent Part-I Annual2022/Semester (I & II) or Part-I Supply 2022 Examination for candidates whose results Annual Part-II/Semester (IV) Examination, latest by the Annual, 2023 (maximum) is awaited. Only those candidates who have passed in first year/two semesters exam are eligible.
  - The admission shall, however, be provisional, subject to the required passing marks of the candidate in Part-II Examination, latest by the Annual Exam/Semester 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023. In case of failure in Annual/Semester 2023 the provisional admission made in 5<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be automatically cancelled.
  - After provisional admission and depositing fee or dues in the Punjab University account, the students shall be required to submit their B.A./B.Sc./Associate Degree (Science/Arts/Commerce) or equivalent Part-II (pass) result card Annual/Semester 2023 within the stipulated time period in the relevant Departments,
- **In case any candidate who is found at any time to have obtained admission by making any mis-statement in the Admission Forms or by concealment of any material fact, (particularly about marks, division, previous admission to the Department/Institute/Center/College, employment, expulsion, conviction etc., and fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down by the University Admission Rules 2023-24, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and all fees or other dues paid by him/her shall be forfeited.**

### **Eligibility for BS or Equivalent Programs:**

- The candidates holding F.A./F.Sc. or equivalent qualification with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> division and aged not more than 24 years are eligible for admission to the **regular programs**. The candidate holding 3<sup>rd</sup> division in his/her terminal degree is not eligible for admission.
- The candidates holding F.A./F.Sc. or equivalent qualification with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> division, except mentioned otherwise, are eligible for admission to the **Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs**. The candidate holding 3<sup>rd</sup> division in his / her terminal degree is not eligible for admission. There is no age limit or session preference for **Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs**.
- No student shall be admitted to a *second* or *subsequent* Master's degree or Law Courses and Undergraduate degree i.e. BS or equivalent in Regular as well as Self Supporting Programs in the University Departments.

### **Eligibility for BS (5<sup>th</sup> Semester) or Equivalent:**

- Candidates holding B.A/B.Sc. /Associate Degree in Science/Arts/Commerce(14-Years of Education) or equivalent qualification with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> Division and aged not more than 26 years are eligible for admission. The candidate holding 3<sup>rd</sup> division in his / her terminal degree is not eligible for admission. **Fifty Percent seats are reserved for graduates from Punjab University and 50% shall be filled on open merit basis.**
- The candidates holding B.A/B.Sc. /Associate Degree in Science/Arts/Commerce(14-Years of Education) or equivalent qualification with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> division are eligible for admission in the **Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs**. Candidates holding 3<sup>rd</sup> division in their terminal degree are not eligible for admission. There is no age limit or session preference for **Self Supporting, Replica, Afternoon & Evening programs**.
- No student shall be admitted to a *second* or *subsequent* Master's degree level or Law Courses and Undergraduate i.e. BS or equivalent in Regular as well as Self Supporting Programs in the Punjab University Departments.

## Basic Criteria of Late Sessions/Years for BS, BS (5<sup>th</sup> Semester) or Equivalent Programs:

- Two marks will be deducted from percentage academic marks for each late session to a maximum of previous five (5) sessions/years for all such candidates.

### Admissions on Reserved Seats:

#### a) Sports Quota:

- **The Applicant must have a proven track record of Sports achievements at various levels. This can include participation and success in relevant sports at International/National, State/Provincial, District, College, School, or club levels. Evidence of participation in Recognised sports competitions or tournaments is mandatory.**
- Two percent seats have been reserved for admission on Sports basis
- Seats will be available only in the morning / regular programs.
- Candidates must bring Admission form mentioning the specific game with light lamination on the day of the trials
- All attested documents will be submitted to the sports office at the time of the sports trials attendance
- Candidates should report on the scheduled date and time in proper Kit/clothing (cricketers must be in the white kit) and must bring their own sportswear & gear (Bats, rackets, hockey sticks, joggers, rifles& cartridges, etc.).
- No separate trials will be conducted for students desirous of admission to the Gujranwala and Jhelum campuses.
- The Sports schedule of sports trials date and venue is available on the P.U web site.
- Applicants must participate in the Punjab University admission test or Specific Departmental Test (Law, Engineering etc.) for undergraduates, which is mandatory even for reserved sports seats. Similarly, he/she must fulfil the requirement of the overall percentage required to apply in that particular discipline (Engineering 60%, Pharmacy60%), or he/she must have the specific subject or combination of subjects needed to apply for the particular discipline.

#### b) Co-curricular Activities Quota:

- Two percent seats have been reserved for admission on the basis of Co-curricular Activities.
- Seats will be available only in the morning / regular programs.
- Final admission will be subject to qualifying trials in the concerned category.
- For admission on the basis of co-curricular activities, the candidates should apply online for their relevant reserve seat /category. For further queries, please contact the relevant office i.e. Directorate of Student Affair (STC), Contact Nos. 0307-4451067 and Office 042-99230181:

#### c) Other Quota:

- Student nominations will be received from Directorate of Colleges & Higher Education, Balochistan, Quetta. Applications will not be acceptable directly from the candidates of **Balochistan Province**.
- Student nominations from **Gilgit-Baltistan** (to be nominated by respective Nomination Board of Gilgit-Baltistan)
- Student nominations from **Sindh** (to be nominated by the respective Nomination Board of Sindh).
- Children of Martyred (Shuhada) of Armed Forces or Security Forces (to be nominated by the relevant quarter/body).
- Ex FATA students should apply separately on the reserve seats while applying online.
- 2% Quota reserved for Special Persons in BS 5<sup>th</sup> Semester and BS 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Program.
- 2% Quota reserved for religious minorities in BS 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Program.
- **Admission for Foreign and Overseas Students**
- Applications from foreign candidates should be routed through candidates' home country's embassy and Pakistan Mission Abroad office (in case of overseas Pakistani) in the office of the Chairman Admission Committee, Centre for Undergraduate Studies, University of the Punjab, Lahore-Pakistan.

### How to Apply Online:

- Online Admission Forms are available for Undergraduate or equivalent programs at <http://admissions.pu.edu.pk> or <http://111.68.103.22/admissions>.
- The portal for online submission will remain open from **Monday, 10-07-2023** and all the candidates are required to fill in & submit this form online till the due date.
- Those candidates, who want to apply for admission against **reserved seats**, need to choose respective reserved quota category(s) in the online form.
- A challan form amounting **Rs.500/-** may be deposited by the candidates in the following Habib Bank Limited (HBL) or United Bank Limited (UBL) accounts. **Habib Bank** Account No. 0042-7900-0843-03, **United Bank** Account No. 2255-9255-1 (**MCA**). The Fee can be paid at any branch of HBL, UBL or Mobile Banking through 1Bill.
- Subject eligibility criteria of individual disciplines will be available online (while filling the admission form) and on the University website as well. The same will also be provided (through e-mail/ telephone only) by the concerned Department/Institute/ Centre/ College.

- All the applicants shall apply separately on morning, evening, replica, self- supporting and reserved quota seats for each discipline. No application submitted once in a category shall be converted/considered for any other category/discipline.
- Incomplete applications forms in any respect and forms of those candidates who have not deposited fee within the given time will not be entertained.
- **Gujranwala and Jhelum Campuses** will follow the same schedules and regulations as those of the Main Campus, University of the Punjab, Lahore.
- Due to limited accommodation facility, University is not bound to provide hostel accommodation to each and every admitted student. **Hostel accommodation facility shall not be provided to the students admitted under Self Supporting, Afternoon, Replica & Evening Programs. Transport& Accommodation facilities are not available for the students at Gujranwala/ Jhelum Campuses.**
- No application will be received in the central Admission office or in any Department/Centre/Institute/College by hand or by post/courier. After the closing date of the online portal for submission of forms, no online facility will be available in any case.
- No call letter/phone call to candidates shall be made separately for selection. Applicants are advised to visit Punjab University/Departmental official website frequently.
- **All University Rules and Regulations shall be applicable to the whole admission process. Errors and Omissions are excepted.**
