

The now historic College of Art and Design of The Punjab University owes its foundation, right from sowing the first seeds of artistic tendency to nurturing it with love, discipline and commitment to a young adult, to none other than Mrs. Anna Molka.

Her migration to Pakistan was a matter of chance and fate, for a young British graduate from The Royal College of Art, to marry a Pakistani Muslim; Sheikh Ahmed. It can be aptly said that the graduate programme was solely her brainchild. It was a period of great difficulty and turmoil, in which she pursued her goal to launch an art institute. The college began enrollments in June of 1942, under her keen eye and supervision. It took more than thirteen years of tireless effort on the part of Mrs. Ahmed to nourish her sapling into a young tree and begin the Masters Programme in Fine Arts in 1955. Anna Molka showed incredible resilience as it took her another decade to establish the Masters Programme in Graphic Design in the year 1964.

She stayed and taught in the college even after her retirement and was aptly bestowed with the title Professor Emeritus. This title was not only an acknowledgement of her incredible serving period of three decades but also of the singular passion, which translated into making this Institute a part of history.

Graphic design creates visual content to communicate messages through print, electronic or digital media, and has become integral for corporate and industrial world. Design, in the recent digital age, is mostly based on interactive software and emerging technologies; whilst rooted in the basics: images, symbols, language of color, typography, and layout. We keep on evolving our acedamic practices to fulfil the needs set by the growing market. Our courses are designed to reshape conventional excercises into modern trends considering the internet age and consumer psycholigy. Specialized subjects; like, advertising and printing, web graphics and marketing, and photography, television commercials and film production, along with courses dealing with language, history, ethics, and socio cultural diversity are taught during the four years of BFA. This discipline prepares students to excell in a highly competitive business world, with an understanding of the diverse global age, by providing them with computerized lab facilities, specialized software and personalized attention.

MFA is more focused on advertising campaigns, complex design issues and bigger projects. Students are made familiar with the working of corporate structures and advertisement agencies. Our aim is to prepare them to challenge the existing trends of mass media and use innovative techniques in reproduction and marketing.

This Department stands out due to its strong association with some of the greatest artists of this century. Many have been students here, and many of these great artists have taught and mentored at the Department of Painting. Their profound influence is, and will always be, a resounding echo along the corridors and the drawing studios of this Department. We must not forget to pay tribute to the models that have sat and still are sitting for long drawn-out hours for live drawing sessions without as much as a frown.

The Department offers a Masters Programme in Painting as well, which encourages the self-expression along with thorough awareness of all the representational techniques available. Students are encouraged to develop personal style and yet have a thorough awareness of art history, ancient civilizations and contemporary styles. This Department is constantly and consistently working to achieve a perfect balance and harmony between the freedom of expression and course-based learning to produce great artists of the future.

PAINTING

The Department of Textile Design offers BFA and MFA Programmes, trying to cater not only the professional needs of our textile sector but also aiming at integrating value-added services for the export department. It is designed to meet new demands and methods with the cloth-weaving heritage of our country that dates back to centuries-old tradition and skill of weaving.

Weaving the technical aspect of fabric building is dependent on finalizing the design first and training the eye and imagination of the students is the next and basic step. We have courses that are tailor-made to cover the historical as well as technological areas of textile design. Labs and studio facilities are made available to learn a variety of application processes that a textile design student must master. The role of computer graphics plus the value of research-based learning is encouraged as the fabric is not only a necessity but also a medium of expression, when used in the process of interior designing. The textile department trains its student to understand the context in which fabric and fabric weaving is a reflection of culture and identity. This discipline holds twofold importance both as a form of personal expression and national identity.

TEXTILE Design





From the earliest forms of printmaking, known as woodcut and lithography, to the modern-day techniques referred to as digital printing, this discipline has evolved not only to express artistic tendencies but as means of preserving great art work. During the print making course, students learn age-old relief techniques like wood engraving and linocut, intaglio techniques like engraving and etching. The course covers a wide and comprehensive area in which lithography, mono-typing and digital techniques are incorporated as well.

Despite being of commercial use, mainly printmaking has been applied to reproducing prints of artworks, with an element of originality. This is where a new dimension is added to the process of printmaking whether it is digital printing or etching, and the thought process of the printmaker comes into play, along with the fact that the print correctly termed an "impression" is not merely a copy but an original work of art. Thus, printmaking stands out as a creative process not for its ability to produce multiple impressions but rather for the unique qualities, each printmaking process lends to itself.



The Department of Architecture is well-renowned both for its teaching faculty that constitutes some of the most recognized and highly qualified architects across the country and the comprehensiveness of its graduate and masters. Programmes. The Programme is further enhanced by providing state of the art technical facilities and studios where proper spaces are made available for technical drawing. Like all art forms, architecture has been the most representational and widely appreciated forms of artistic skill. It represents all aspects of life in general planning, designing and construction and all elements of living style, in particular, whether it is rural or urban, classic or contemporary.

Our Department shoulders the responsibility of preserving our social and cultural heritage but also providing the technical expertise to keep up with the demands of the changing times. Our degrees are fully accredited, recognized and regulated by the Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (PCATP). The architects learn to design both at the macro and micro levels, create conceptual spaces for both rural and urban environment and must fulfill considerations of beauty and utility at the same time.

ARCHITECTURE





Sculpture is the branch of the visual arts that operates in three dimensions. Traditionally, sculptural process has focused on carving and modeling, generally in clay, stone, metal, and wood. However, since modernism, shifts in the sculptural process have led to an almost complete freedom of materials and process. To keep the materials and insight, required for this Degree Programme up to date, is the main purpose of this course. Man has created three-dimensional figures as well as relief sculpture ever since he began experimenting with the qualities of stone, metal, clay and wood.

The modern approach to sculpture is emphasized, along with the necessity of pairing this course with theoretical studies in art. Sculpture has undergone complex changes in the past decade or so; installation art has become an important part of sculpture, and its social and geographical context is widely appreciated in a world where art and artists are known for originality and diversity. We, at the helm of this Department, ensure that this three-dimensional art form is taught with zeal and credibility. To merge the classical with the contemporary, and making the spatial and visual dimensions of this art meaningful, is the extraordinary task, our course tries to fulfill.

SCULPTURE

The Department of Musicology was established in 2006, and offers a unique opportunity to study for a Masters Programme in this discipline, the first public University in Pakistan to do so. The need for emotional expression through the medium of music is both an art and a science. Our Department aims to combine the impassioned sensibility of a musician with a sound awareness of the historical, socio-cultural and linguistic barriers that music permeates.

In our present times, the need to understand and promote music has become more important for the stifling pressures the young generation faces can have a positive outlet if channeled through the expressive medium of music. The language, genre and style of music know no boundaries yet the classical tradition as rooted in our heritage is both our identity and our pride. Many of the renowned names associated with this Department provide a great platform for the young artist and musician whose aim is integration of academic and professional boundaries.

Although the music department is still in its infant years, the course teaches music history in a well-rounded way, and the faculty is fulfilling a great service by collaborating with theater and holding workshops to provide the much needed exposure that any student of music requires.

MUSICOLOGY









The commencement of the PhD and M. Phil Programme in Art and Design (Studio-practice & Art History), has been the most notable development within the field of academic enlightenment at The College of Art and Design, and in all probabilities, that started in 2003, under the umbrella of Higher Education Commission (HEC).

Through this initiative, a long-awaited vacuumed field of research in the field of visual arts, design, architecture and alike, has been catered so well that in a very short span of time, a considerable number of Ph. D and huge number of M. Phil students have received their degrees through a well-designed theoretical route, compatible with international standards. The need for research in the field of Fine Arts or Design, has been an un-addressed aspect throughout academic art in Pakistan. Therefore, the enthusiastic researchers had to go abroad for their higher-level degrees. However, since the commencement of the doctoral programme, the local students who want to carry on their education to the next higher levels, should be facilitated at their home without having troubles of going out of the country and bearing large sums of fee and lodging.

The course encompasses several methods of studying visual art, its historical contexts and its stylistic development. This includes major arts of painting, sculpture and architecture as well as the related subjects of art history and art criticism. History of Western Art, History of south Asian Art, History of Muslim Architecture and Art in Pakistan are the notable subjects and fields that the research scholars are studied.



Professional Diploma in Graphic Design

The diploma course introduces students to the basic of design and colour through carefully planned studio projects in the foundation level. It further offers designing of logo and stationery, design for information, communication and persuasion with emphasis on print.

Professional Diploma in Painting

The diploma course introduces students to image painting techniques in pastel, oils, watercolors and acrylics. Conceptual work is preferred but a balance is maintained with painting still-life, landscapes and portraits, as well as composition.

Professional Diploma in Drawing

This course seeks to develop the basic skills of observation and drawing, through a systematic study of models under different light conditions. Students are encouraged to show volume and perspective in three-dimensional forms through shading.


Professional Diploma in Print Making

This course introduces the autographic methods of printing as a medium of expression for the artist. Students work on techniques of planography, relief printing and intaglio process. At the completion of the course, students become proficient in the basic technique of print making.

PROFESSIONAL Diplomas







Professional Diploma in Sculpture

Through this course students are encouraged to develop their skills and observation through practical experiments with different materials. At the completion of the course, students become proficient in the knowledge of traditional and modern techniques in sculpture.

Professional Diploma in Calligraphy

This intensive course aims at teaching control of line, form and shape through the age-old practice of writing with a 'qalam'. The lesson to be learned is the understanding of disciplines as well aesthetics of the beautiful art of calligraphy.

Professional Diploma in Photography

The importance of photography cannot be understated in this day and age. It is a subject that plays a vital role in every aspect of life. Students are given a thorough understanding of the camera and its processes; digital as well as analogue and the role of the computer in photographic production.

Professional Diploma in Interior Design

Closely linked to Architecture, this course teaches students about the dynamics of space, structure, texture, color, etc. in an attempt to address issues of designs in the interior of building such as residential homes, shops, hotels, hospitals and alike.

Professional Diploma in Textile Design

The textile diploma focuses on the fundamentals of textile design. Our aim is to include a diversity, of techniques and designs of textile, into our course and produce talented individuals ready for the industry.


