### Prof. Dr. Kanwal Ameen Appointed as Vice Chancellor at University of Home Economics

Prof. Dr. Kanwal Ameen is appointed as first Vice Chancellor at University of Home Economics by the Higher Education Department, Government of the Punjab w.e.f.31.05.2019 for a period of four years. Earlier in this year, she also received James M. Cretsos Leadership Award from Association for Information Science and Technology (ASIS&T), a prestigious non-profit organization for information professionals. She also got an award for Indigenous Post-Doctoral Supervision (2018-2019), from Punjab Higher Education Commission (PHEC).
