The atlas is a good guide for the students of Geography and Economics and contains a good deal of useful information. A number of maps in the economic section are highly informative. The distributional maps are usually supplemented by bar diagrams in colours. However, the reading of these bar diagrams is rather difficult as too much of information is attempted to be compressed in them. The statistical data used in the compilation of several diagrams are of wide range. The utility of the atlas for Pakistani students could have increased manifold had it included separate maps of Pakistan on larger scales than the present Indo-Pakistan maps showing the international boundaries between the two countries.
