- 2. The Focal Persons will register all the students on the PU Employment Portal.
- 3. Create an active linkage with the alums for counselling and placement opportunities.
- 4. Create a CV folder of the passing out graduates of their respective department and send a soft copy to this office to explore job opportunities for them.

CCPC shall enhance the linkages with the HR departments and create more placement and internship opportunities for the PU students and graduates.


