- 16 2. Integrate learning: Synthesize knowledge from various courses to address a real-world horticultural issue
- 17 or problem.
- 18 3. Develop problem-solving skills: Design, implement, and evaluate a solution to a horticultural problem or
- 19 challenge.
- 20 4. Foster critical thinking: Analyze complex horticultural issues, evaluate evidence, and develop well-
- 21 supported conclusions.
- 22 5. Encourage creativity and innovation: Develop novel solutions, products, or services that address
- 23 horticultural needs or opportunities.
- 24 6. Prepare for professional practice: Demonstrate readiness for entry-level positions in horticulture or
- 25 related fields.
