Course Title	Textual Study of <i>Hadīth</i> -II			Semester	III
Course Introduction					
<p>This course is structured into two distinct components. The initial segment provides an in-depth introduction to the sciences of <i>Hadīth</i>. In the second part, students will engage in a focused and selective study of <i>Hadīths</i> drawn from the <i>Sahah-e-Sittah</i>, the six canonical books extensively taught in religious seminaries. This targeted study is designed to empower students, enhancing their competence in navigating and comprehending the rich landscape of <i>Hadīth</i> literature. By the conclusion of the course, students will have acquired the skills necessary to consult and understand <i>Hadīths</i> with a greater depth of knowledge and critical analysis.</p>

<p>Upon completing the course, students will possess a comprehensive understanding of <i>Hadīth</i> literature, including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Graduates will engage in in-depth textual study of <i>Hadīth</i> compilations, gaining proficiency in deciphering and analyzing <i>Hadīth</i> texts. 2. The course will equip students with the research skills necessary for exploring and evaluating <i>Hadīth</i> narrations, their authenticity, and historical context. 3. Students will establish a meaningful connection with <i>Hadīth</i> literature, fostering a deep appreciation for the sayings and actions of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). 4. They will learn the methodologies employed in <i>Hadīth</i> authentication, enabling them to distinguish between authentic and weak narrations.

1.	Midterm Assessment	35%	Written Assessment at the mid-point of the semester.

2.	Formative Assessment	25%	Continuous assessment includes Classroom participation, assignments, presentations, viva voce, attitude and behavior, direct activities, short tests, projects, practical, reflections, readings, quizzes etc.
3.	Final Assessment	40%	Written Examination at the end of the semester. It is mostly in the form of a test, but owing to the nature of the course the teacher may assess their students based on term paper, research proposal development, field work and report writing etc.
