<p>This course is the continuation of Research Thesis offered in Semester VII. The Psychology Research Thesis will provide undergraduate students with an opportunity to conduct an independent research project under the supervision of a faculty member, culminating in a written thesis. Students will also attend weekly meetings to discuss: (a) general topics important to conducting research; (b) student research proposals; and (c) the outcomes of research projects.</p> <p>Each and every student will complete the research project based on quantitative or qualitative method of investigation.</p>
