BFAT102 : Basic Design-II

Credit hr: 6 P

Objective:

The course aims to establish the design students at an advance level so that they understand the textile design on the whole. They are taught design as in specialized term and execution so that they are able to deliver in the textile field.

Content:

The course aims to induce the design elements and principals to the students at an advance level so that they understand the complex meaning and presentation of textile design. They are taught textile design as in specialization further correlating it with the textile technology.

Course work plan: (16 weeks)

The 16 weeks may be divided according to the teacher's convenience and choice at 1 week per assignment or 2 weeks per assignment leading to 16 assignments or 8 assignments respectively. It is a flexible method of time division and the only focus is on the proper impartation of course objectives and the contents as stated above.
