

Foreword

This brief fact book on the University of the Punjab provides readers all basic facts and figures pertaining to the University for the years 2018-19. I would like to thank Dr. Muhammad Khalid Khan (Registrar), Mr. Jaleel Tariq (Resident Officer-I), Mr. Amjad Pervaiz (Director Press & Publications) and Mr. Mahmood Alam (Staff Officer to VC) for their contribution to this fact book.

University of the Punjab is the oldest and the largest seat of learning in Pakistan. It comprises 13 faculties and 83 departments wherein 44660 students are admitted in about 350 academic programs. The University has about 615 affiliated colleges with about 275,811 students admitted in various disciplines.

There are 907 regular faculty members with 497 Ph.D. degree holders. The Ph.D. to non-Ph.D. ratio has increased by 54.80 % for regular faculty members in the year 2018. The University has strengthened its M.Phil./MS and Ph.D. programs. In the year 2018-19 student enrollment in M.Phil. and Ph.D. classes rose to 7707 and 2098 respectively. In 2018, 1945 M.Phil. and 192 Ph.D. graduates have completed their degrees. The number of Ph.D. students at the University also increased up to 5% during the current session.

The readers will notice that certain basic indicators of performance of the university have improved steadily and

significantly over time. The number of research publications carrying an impact-factor and HEC recognized journals has increased. This year the number of total research publications reached 1505.

Research funding has been increased up to Rs. 150 million in 2018. A research endowment fund (started with 250 million in 2010) currently stands at Rs 600 million in addition to this funding. An amount of Rs. 70 million has been allocated for Faculty Development in 2018-19 in addition to HEC and PHEC funded Faculty Development programs. An endowment fund of Rs. 33 million has also been setup for the welfare of employees. The investment of PU has risen to Rs. 7.250 Billion in December, 2018.

To alleviate financial hardships of students, needy & merit scholarships are provided. In 2018, more than 25% of the regular students were provided scholarships. We received Rs. 142.566 million as fees from regular students and disbursed scholarships worth Rs. 73.6 million amongst the students from the income of University of the Punjab. The HEC provided scholarships worth Rs. 97.456 million whereas the Government of the Punjab provided scholarships worth Rs. 26.863 million.

A first Alumni Reunion Function was arranged on 8th December, 2018 that became a huge success and was able to bring alumni from different walks of life under one roof. The alumni comprises of leading journalists, scientists, lawyers, judges, actors, politicians, businessmen and civil servants.

The University first time launched online Admissions System of the students for the session Fall – 2018 and received over 150,000 applications out of which about 12000 were admitted. This facility helped students to apply for admission easily with low cost and their door steps.

The University management has taken initiative to materialize the plan of establishment of Medical College and Hospital.

The University of the Punjab has jumped up significantly in international universities ranking during this year as shown in table No.21.

At the end of the booklet we have answers of FAQ's for further information of the readers. It is expected that this fact book, will be helpful for persons seeking information about Punjab University at a glance.




