- Q. # 4: Read the following passage carefully and answer the questions given at the end. (25)**

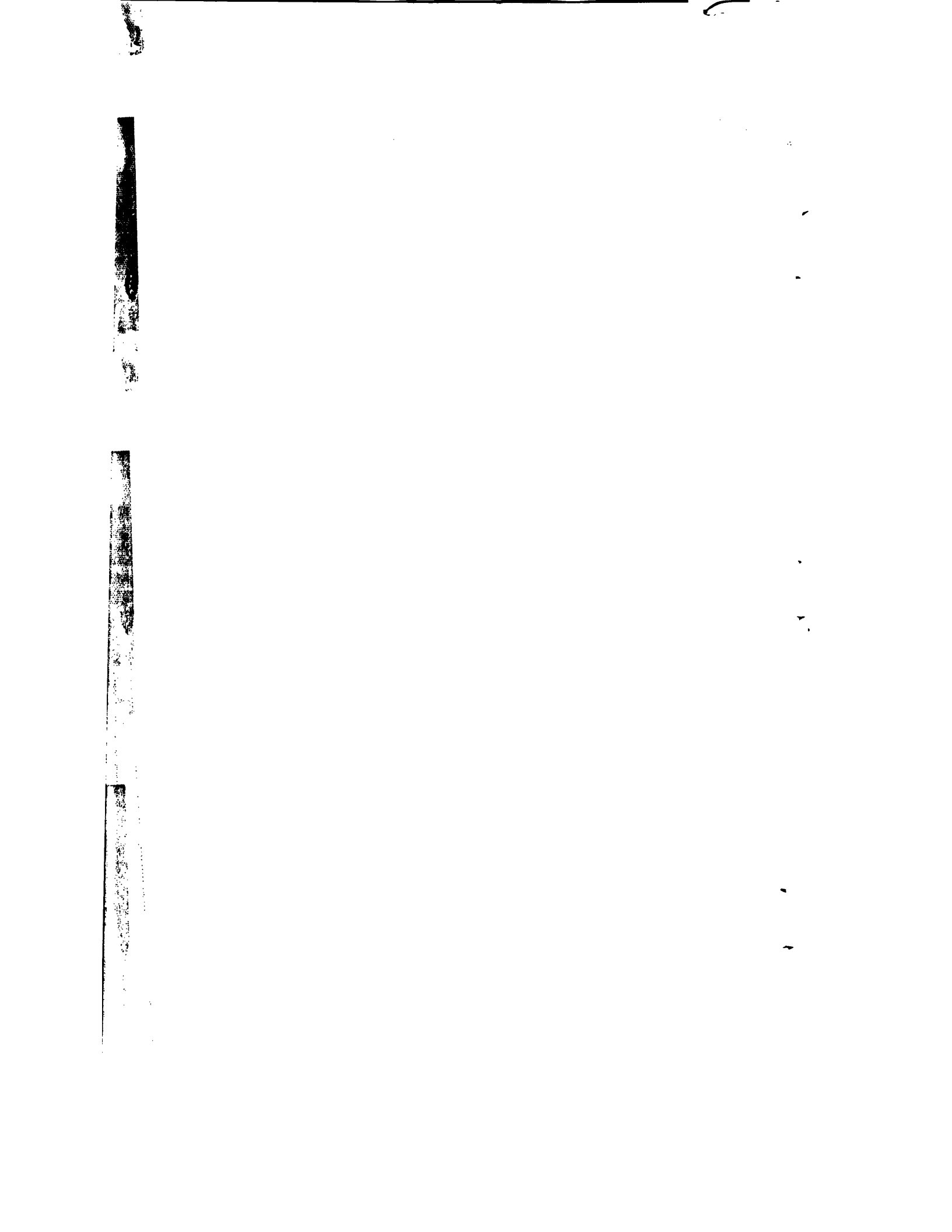
A scientist in the grown-up world must have certain number of facts, principles and theories at his finger-tips. He must also know how to calculate from them. But science would stand still - indeed it would cease to be science --- if scientists merely worked from fixed sets of facts and theories. The essence of science is the gathering of old facts and establishment of new theories when new facts fail, as they often do, to match existing theories. Science has advanced in a spectacular fashion in recent history because scientists have been greedy for new knowledge, and because they have been so ready to disbelieve the text-books of their youth.

It is, therefore, most important to give our young students of science an awareness of the scepticism and openmindedness that is part of the very soul of science. Of course, it would be absurd to ask them to do serious research or formulate theories, but the science course should at least teach them what an immense part is played by research in real science and mention some of the tremendous revolutions in theory which have marked the great advances of science. Let them not think that any branch is a subject that one can sit down and learn. Let them realize that science is essentially a creative activity.
