

## Accreditation History of IMME

The undergraduate Metallurgy and Materials Engineering program at the Institute of Metallurgy and Materials Engineering (IMME) is accredited by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC), a signatory of the Washington Accord (WA), ensuring compliance with internationally recognized engineering education standards.

The program has undergone multiple PEC accreditation and re-accreditation visits. In the most recent evaluation, IMME was awarded Level II accreditation for three academic sessions (2019–2021), reflecting the Institute’s commitment to quality education and continuous improvement. The history of the PEC teams' visits to IMME over the last decade is provided as under.
