

### **ADMISSION TEST POLICY GUIDELINES**

- i. **Test for MPhil:** The subject test is required, and in addition, the test must include questions on English/Verbal Reasoning, Analytical Reasoning, and Quantitative Reasoning (as already notified by DPCC vide letter D/37/DPCC dated 10th June 2016).
- ii. **The test for PhD** will be in two parts, **Part A (100 marks)** and **Part B (100 marks)**
  - a) **Part A: GRE/HAT general type (Annexure I-guidelines for Content Weightages of English/Verbal Reasoning, Analytical Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning), and it is mandatory to score 60% marks in Part A, which will be MCQ-based and of maximum marks -100 marks**
  - b) **Part B:** Relevant Subject-based test (It is up to departments/ institutions/ centres/ schools/ colleges to prepare this portion, either subjective or objective MCQs based.
  - c) It is mandatory to score 60% in the cumulative in the entry test.
