Prof. Dr. Nosheen Fatima Warraich



Additionally, in Asia, the institute got the prestigious 18th position while globally ranked among the elite slot of top 50-71 LIS schools.

IIM Faculty and Scholar's Research Output

This prestigious ranking, compiled by Stanford University in collaboration with Elsevier, acknowledges researchers based on their scientific impact, citation metrics, and contributions to their respective fields. This recognition is a testament to his scholarly excellence and the impact of his work on the global research community.
